The Cemetery - established 1851

Findagrave.com tells us that there are 346 people buried at Ebenezer. Quite a few are unmarked graves, especially those of infants and children from the late 1800s. One source tells us that the first burial in the cemetery was a child in 1870 - Ellen Florrance Blose, daughter of Boaz Devos Blose and Susannah Smith. Since Jacob and Susannah died in 1866 and 1854, likely they were among the first.

Did you know:

- Jacob and Susannah Mauk are buried here.
 They moved to Jefferson County about 1835 from Bedford County
- Only 5 of Jacob and Susannah Mauk's 16 children are buried here: Henry, Samuel, Barbara, Isaac and Eve
- There are 27 people with the last name Mauk, 7 with the maiden name Mauk and 14 people with the last name Lingenfelter found here
- The most common name is Shafer/Shaffer with 31 people.
- 172 people are not Mauk (not Mauk last name nor married to a Mauk)
