- Three of his four living children lived with him.
- His 22 year old son was a laborer while his 18 year old daughter kept house.

Hemlock bark was used in the tanning industry. The bark was harvested from May through August. A 1914 Department of Commerce report, *The Lumber Industry*, noted “... in Pennsylvania the [hemlock] lumber may almost be said to be a by-product of the tanning industry”.

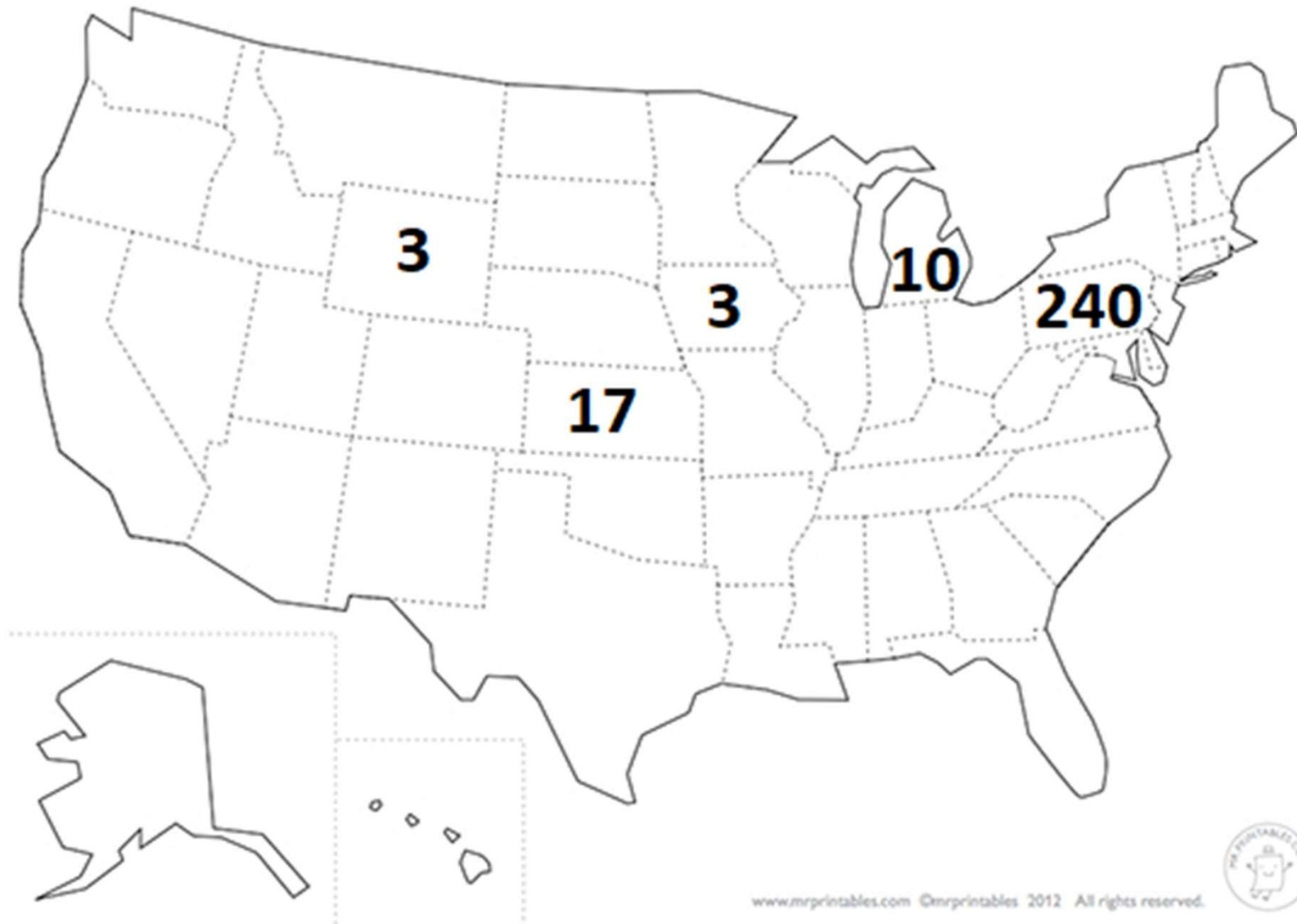

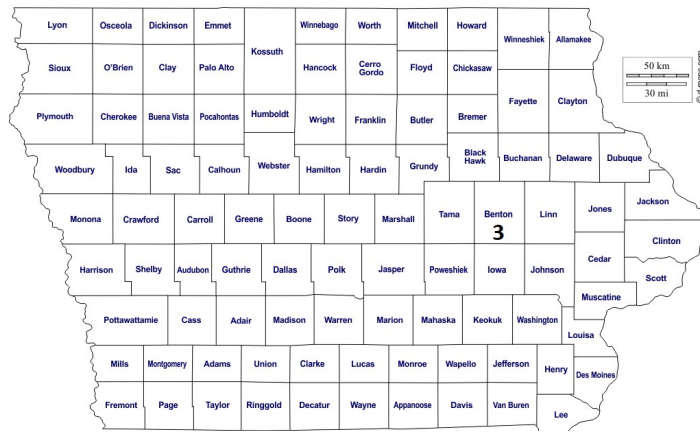

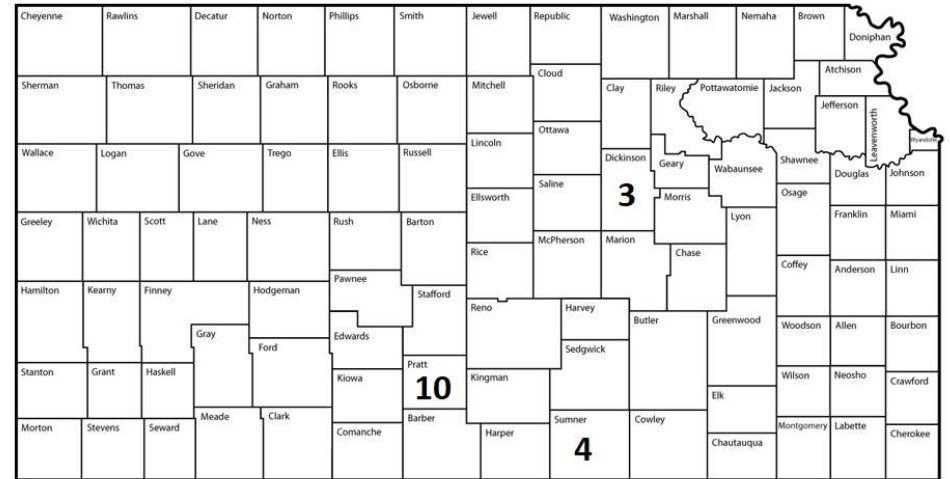


Descendants in West in 1880 Census

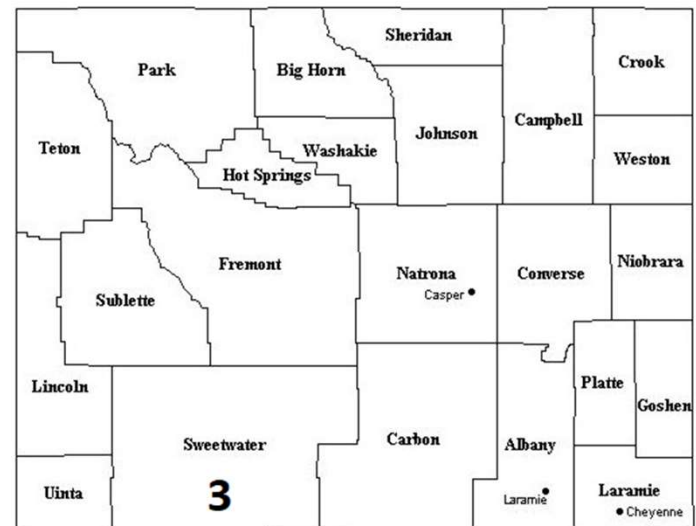

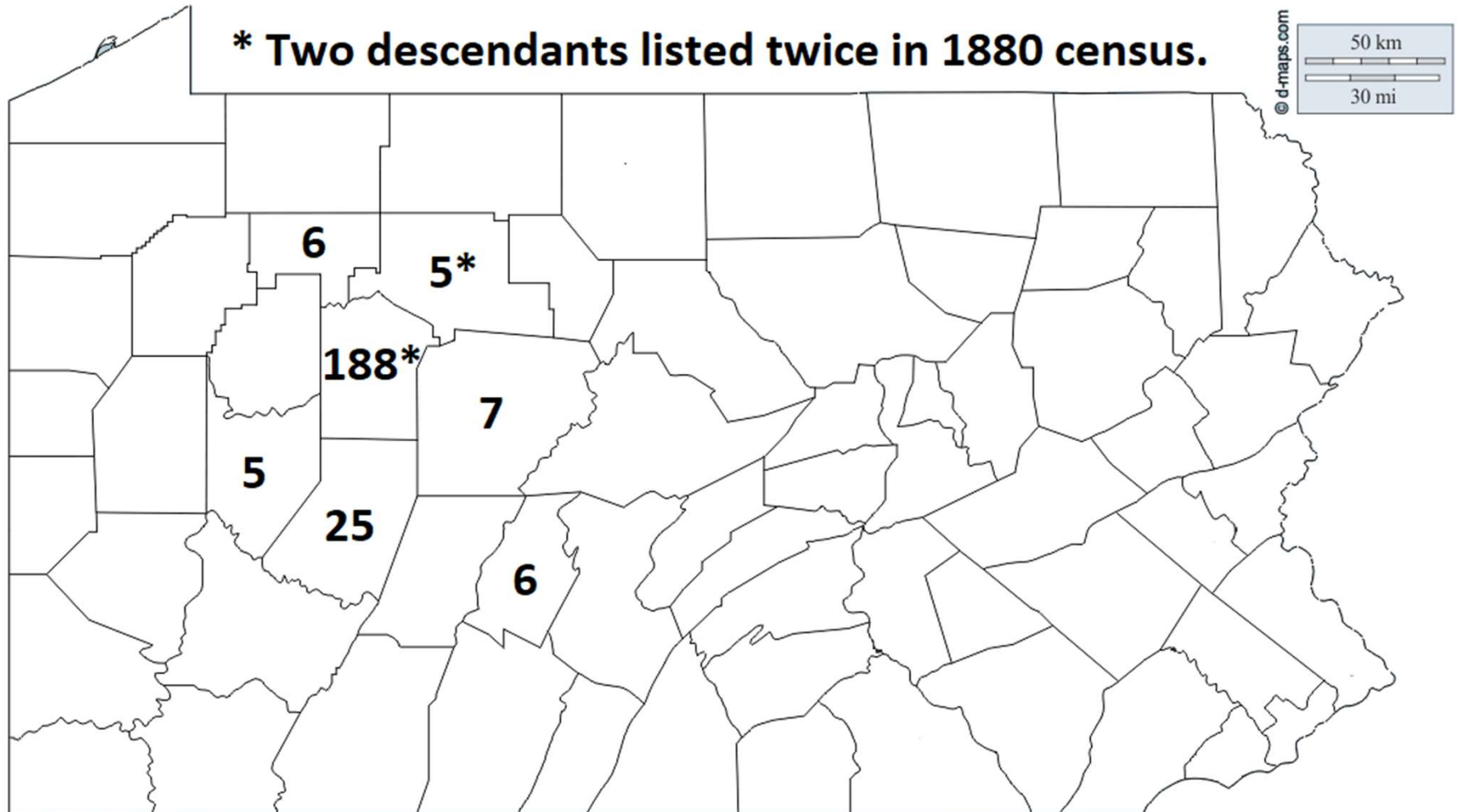
