

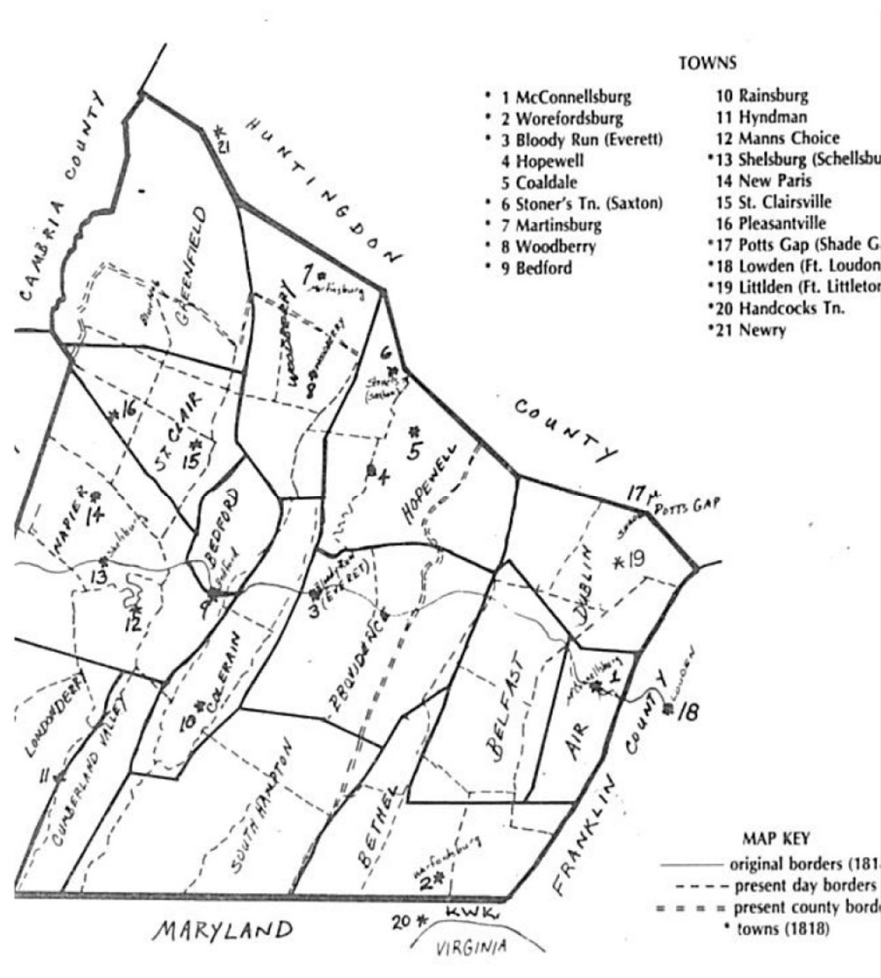

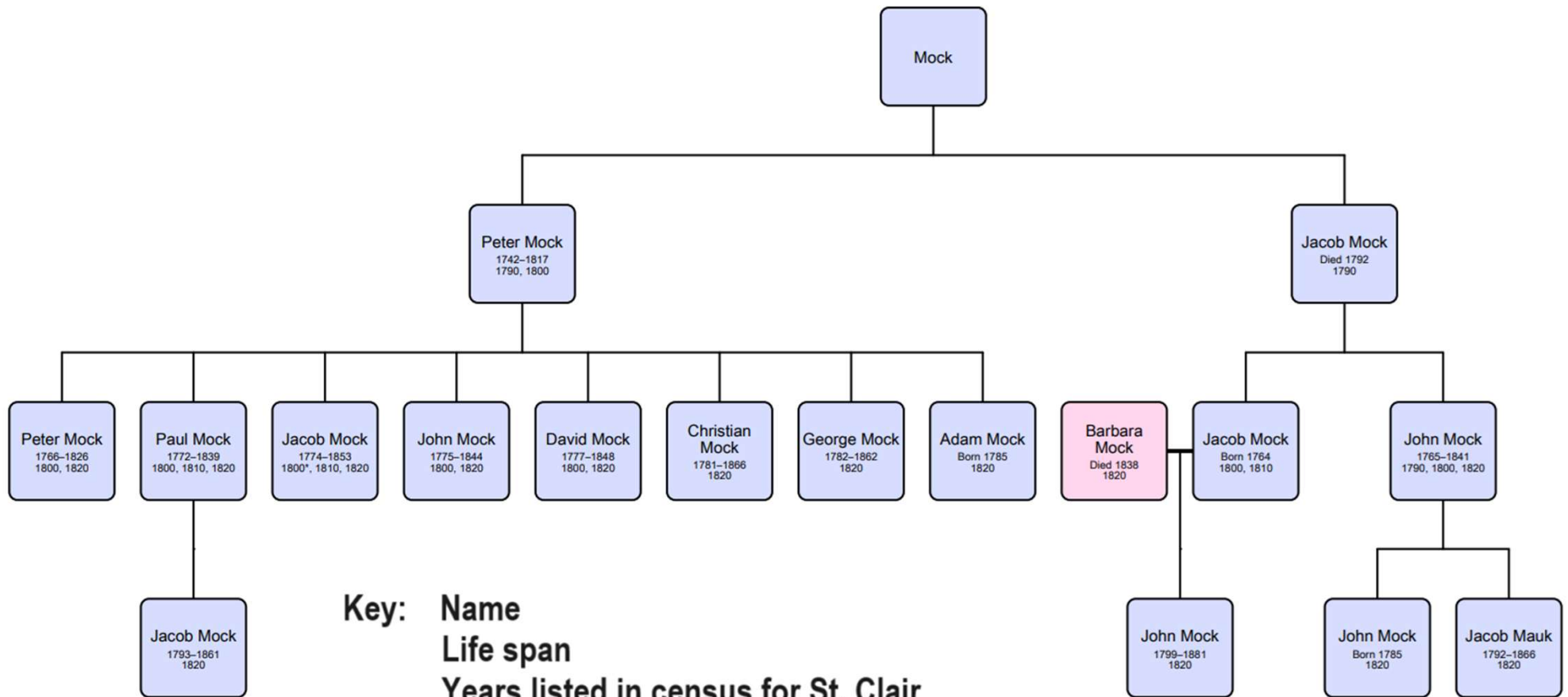

- Possibilities for Jacob Mock's household:
 - M 16+: Jacob and his son Jacob (b. 1764).
 - M<16: Christian, his son, who died before Jacob's 1791 will was written or Jacob 3rd?
 - F: Merci Dority (his wife), Dority (his youngest daughter), Elizabeth (his granddaughter who lives with him) and daughters "Sarrah" and Mary are mentioned in the 1791 will. Perhaps Elizabeth was not yet with this household in 1790?
- Possibilities for Peter Mock's household:
 - M 16+: Peter and sons Peter (1766-1826), Paul (1772-1839) and *Jacob (1774-1853)*.
 - M<16: *Jacob (1774-1853)*, John (1775-1844), David (1777-1848), Christian (1781-1855), George (1782-1862), Adam (1785-1865). 8 sons total but 7 other males listed. One lived elsewhere?
 - F: Elizabeth (his wife) and Fanny (his daughter who later married Frederick Carn).
- Possibilities for John Mock's household:
 - M 16+: John.
 - M<16: John (1784-1819), his son.
 - F: Elizabeth Bowser (his wife) and his daughters Maria (d. 1839) and Dorothy.
 - These daughters are listed by Fred Ickes in his book MOCK-MAUK GENEALOGY.

1790 Census – Related Families

- Barbara Walter
 - Susannah Walters paternal grandmother.
- John Bowser
 - Elizabeth Bowser's father and the maternal grandfather of Jacob Mauk (1792-1866)
 - Other Bowser families listed: George, Michael & David Bowser.
- Conrad Messenheimer
 - His daughter, Barbara, married Jacob Mock (b. 1764).
- Peter Imler
 - A first cousin of our Susannah's father, Henry Walter.
 - Peter was married to a daughter of Abram Lingenfelter.
- Abram Lingenfelter
 - Ancestor of Jefferson County Lingenfelters.

 - Daughters Susannah (1794-1833), Dorothy (1797-1857) and Elizabeth (1799-1872).

 - Sons Philip (b. 1798) and John (1799-1881).
 - Daughter Elizabeth (1792-1876).
 - Unknown male and female under 10.
- Possibilities for David Mock's household:
 - David (1777-1848)
 - His wife, Elizabeth Bowser (1770-1863).
 - Daughter Sarah (b. 1799).
- Possibilities for John Mock's household:
 - John (1775-1844) and his wife, Anna (d. 1852).
 - McEspy, raised by John.
 - Unknown female over 45.
- Possibilities for Peter Mock Jr.'s household:
 - Peter (1766-1826).
 - Catharina Carn (1776-1856), his wife.
 - Daughters Frances (b. 1796), Elizabeth (1798-1845) and MArgaret
 - Unknown male under 10 (Thomas?).
- Possibilities for Jacob Mock's household:
 - A duplicate entry for Jacob Mock (1774-1853).
 - Or also listed as Jacob 3rd in the 1810 census?


